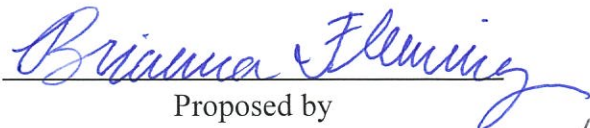


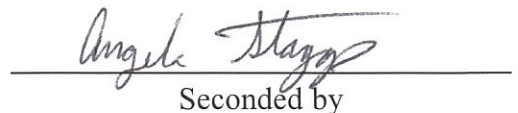
STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION
A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- I. This Act shall be known and cited as Who Shall Serve? Reformation.
- II. The purpose of this bill is to ensure that the Secretary's position is filled properly in their absence and to clarify equality among members of the executive council and smooth proceedings in the executive branch.
- III. Section 200.9 currently reads:
In the event that the SGA Secretary is absent from whole or part of a Senate meeting, the Historian shall serve in their place. If both the Secretary and the Historian are absent, then the SGA Treasurer shall serve in their places, until the conclusion of the meeting or the Secretary or Historian returns.
- IV. Section 200.9 now shall read:
In the event that the SGA Secretary is absent from the whole or part of a Senate meeting, the Historian shall serve in place of the Secretary until the conclusion of the meeting or the Secretary returns.
- V. This bill will become law upon ratification by two--thirds (2/3) vote of the University of North Alabama Student Government Association Senate and the subsequent approval of the Student Government Association President and Vice President.
